

Instructions for Psychological Testing

Psychological testing and evaluation for gifted students or for learning disabilities will consist of two appointments.

1. Initial interview with the client/student, and with parents if the student is a minor. Background information will be obtained, and prior evaluations and other documentation will be reviewed.
The testing will immediately follow this interview.
Total appointment time: 3 hours for gifted evaluations; 5 hours for LD
2. Feedback session approximately one week following the testing session. A written report of the findings will be provided. Appointment time: 30 minutes – 1 hour

Additional instructions and payment information:

- Client/student to be tested should take prescription medications as they are normally prescribed on the day of the evaluation.
- Please bring copies of any prior psychological testing or evaluation.
- Please bring a copy of the IEP if applicable.
- If possible, please email, fax, or U.S. mail any documentation regarding the type of evaluation needed prior to the first appointment (such as a letter, report, or school form requesting the psychological testing). Otherwise, please bring this documentation to the first session.

Your cooperation in providing this information will help with the evaluation process, so that we're sure to meet your exact needs for psychological testing.

Fees for psychological testing and evaluation are payable in full at the beginning of the first session.
